

BYLAW NO. 1-76

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VICTORY NO. 226 FOR THE USE OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT.

The council of the Village of Beechy in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

It shall be lawful for the Village of Beechy to enter into an agreement, the terms of which are attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" with the Rural Municipality of Victory No. 226 for the use of the fire fighting equipment, in extinguishing fires within the limits of the said municipality, and operating a joint fire department with the Rural Municipality of Victory No. 226, and the Mayor and Secretary Treasurer of the Village of Beechy are hereby authorized to sign and execute an agreement, the terms of which are set out in Exhibit "A" hereinbefore referred to.
