## Schedule 1

## 2024 Lagoon Usage Agreement

Between:

The Village of Beechy And Sask Valley Oilfield Maintenance

(Hereinafter referred to as the "sewage hauler")

- It is understood that this agreement entitles Sask Valley Oilfield Maintenance access to the Village of Beechy's lagoon for the 2024 calendar year, legally located at SW ¼ 18 22 10 W3rd, for the purposes of discharging effluent as collected and stored by the Prairie Lake Regional Park. This agreement does not cover any further subdivision of this land.
- It is agreed that the lagoon usage fees are set at .01/gallon or a minimum \$40.00/dump.
  Payment is due and payable within 30 days from the end of each month to the Village of Beechy.
- The sewage hauler will provide detailed usage/volume information to Beechy monthly. Failure to receive the volume information may result in the termination of this agreement.
- 4. It is understood that the sewage hauler must follow the Water Security Agency's requirement to hold a valid permit, the <u>Permit to Transport and Dispose of Liquid Domestic Waste (WSA-505)</u> as well as any other Provincial Legislative Requirements.
- 5. It is agreed that an appropriate discharging site be installed for use by the sewage hauler to mitigate erosion, and failure to use this site will result in termination of this agreement. Furthermore, that all expenses in relation to this discharge site will be paid for by Prairie Lake Regional Park.
- The sewage hauler will provide a properly equipped vehicle, supplied and engaged for the sole purpose of transporting and discharging effluent.
- 7. It is understood that if provincial regulations change in regards to the operation of Beechy's lagoon, this agreement will also be subject to change, and may even be terminated if Beechy is no longer able to accommodate Prairie Lake Regional Park's effluent due to any legislated or volume capacity changes.
- The Village of Beechy reserves the right to make amendments, restrictions or additions to requirements of the sewage hauler as deemed necessary, to first and foremost protect the integrity and capacity of the lagoon for Village of Beechy ratepayers.
- This agreement may be renegotiated annually, but may not necessarily be extended any further than this initial agreement.
- 10. The deadline for acceptance of this agreement is February 29th 2024.
- 11. This agreement is in effect until December 31st 2027 and will be reviewed annually.

## Bylaw No - 01-2024

A Bylaw to enter into an agreement between The Village of Beechy and Sask Valley Oilfield Maintenance For the purpose of providing lagoon usage

The Council of the Village of Beechy in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. That Sask Valley Oilfield Maintenance enter into an agreement with the Village of Beechy which will allow access to Beechy's lagoon for 3 years for the purposes of discharging effluent as collected and stored by the Prairie Lake Regional Park. This Bylaw will expire December 31st of 2027, or until either party terminates said agreement in writing.
- 2. The Mayor and Administrator of the Village of Beechy are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreements identified as Schedule 1.
- 3. Accounts shall be paid within a period of thirty days from the date on which such accounts are rendered. If an account is not paid within the period of thirty days, access will be denied.
- 4. The fees contained in these agreements shall come into force and take effect on the day of passing and shall be in effect until December 31st 2027, with fees to be reviewed

5. Bylaw No 01-2022 is hereby repealed.
