

A BYLAW TO GOVERN THE BUILDING AND REPAIR OF SIDEWALKS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BEECHY

The Council of the Village of Beechy in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. The Village will buy the materials (cement and gravel) and supply the forms, if the homeowner does the work on all new sidewalks.
2. If the homeowner elects to use redi-mix for a new sidewalk, the Village will pay the equivalent cost per yard, for the gravel and cement as it would cost to be done by the homeowner.
3. Sidewalks are to be 66' from the inside of the sidewalk on one side to the inside of the sidewalk across the street. Sidewalks are to be 4' wide and 4" deep except as noted in item 4.
4. When a sidewalk crosses an approach or driveway for access to a yard or alleyway the depth of the sidewalk must be an additional 4" thick to total 8" for the entire width of the approach or driveway. The cost of this additional 4", crossing a homeowners private driveway or access lane must be paid by the homeowner.
5. The cost of repair of a homeowners existing sidewalk will be paid by homeowner if it is caused due to neglect or abuse.
6. If conditions necessitate the Village to remove or disrupt an existing sidewalk it will be replaced or repaired at the discretion of the Council.
7. It is in violation of this bylaw <sup>For a Vehicle RB</sup> to cross any portion of an existing sidewalk except on a reinforced (8" thick portion) driveway or approach.
