2025 Taxes-Where Do Our Municipal Tax Dollars Go?
2025 Taxes will be levied at the end of July. The 2025 mill rate has remained the same this year at 9.5 mills. Even though 2025 was a revaluation year in property assessment, the majority of residential property owners should see a similar tax levy, or a small decrease from 2024.

Where do your municipal tax dollars go? As a Village, we have many commitments in the provision of services to our residents. The following shows some of the larger “behind the scenes” expenses, not typically as obvious; such as garbage pick-up, providing clean and safe drinking water or snow removal- but are still necessary and sometimes compulsory for the operation of a community.

The Education Property Tax (EPT) mill rate, which is set by the province, has also decreased this year for both residential and commercial properties. Village homeowners will see a decrease in the amount of EPT paid, with the rate decreasing from 4.54 mills, to 4.27 mills. Municipalities are required by statute to collect this money on behalf of the province, which in turn distributes it directly to our school division (Sunwest).

These are just a sample of some of the mandatory expenses that your tax dollars fund.





Remember, that taxes are due by December 31st of 2025; and that late tax payments will be penalized with an 12% interest. The Village of Beechy welcomes any questions you may have regarding the municipal portion of the mill rate and your taxes.
