Sewer Lines

Inappropriate items being flushed down the toilet can (and has) created community sewer and lagoon issues. Although chemical products help in the breakdown of sewage, no chemical is strong enough to dissolve some of the items being introduced to our sewer system. Not only is it time consuming and costly to the Village to snake and jet sewer lines- but a serious plug could form in the lagoon inlet pipe, resulting in major backups and costly repairs.

Keep these items out of the sewer and throw them in the garbage instead:

 * Feminine hygiene products *Baby/Personal Care Wipes *Diapers and condoms * Paper towel and tissue paper * Cotton swabs/balls/ Q-tips
*Fats, oils and grease

Is your furry friend licensed with the Village of Beechy?

In accordance with the Beechy Animal Bylaw 04-2024, every dog over 12 weeks of age and every cat over 8 weeks of age must be licensed with the Village. The fee is a onetime fee for the life of the animal and are as follows: \$20.00 for non-sterilized (non-fixed) dogs and cats, and \$10.00 for sterilized (fixed) dogs and cats.
